



ECHO TRAINING PROGRAMS

PRACTICAL ECHO TRAINING PROGRAM

The program is designed for cardiac technologists or medical staff wanting to develop the hands-on skills necessary to perform a routine adult transthoracic echo. No previous echo experience is necessary; however a basic knowledge of the cardiovascular system is required.

Two 3.5 hour sessions are provided each week over 22 weeks starting with the routine windows, views and measurements then advancing to echo calculations and an introduction to cardiac pathology. Only 2 students participate in each training session allowing ample hands-on time. Students will practice on demo patients to gain confidence in image acquisition and be exposed to pathology via pre-recorded images.

Duration:

154 hrs spread over 22 weeks
(2 half days each week) or 11
weeks (2 full days each week).

ECHOCARDIOGRAPHY FOR THE CRITICAL CARE PHYSICIAN

The program is designed for medical professionals working in the critical care setting. No previous echo experience is necessary, however the course assumes a prior knowledge of cardiac anatomy, physiology and haemodynamics. The program is designed to facilitate the diagnosis and management of patients in the critical care setting. With a focus on developing the practical skills of echocardiography, the program is delivered over 6 weeks with a combination of face to face skill development sessions, which are delivered over 2 three-day weekends, on-line units and independent workplace scanning. The hands-on sessions are coupled with tutorials and case review sessions to develop skills and confidence in using transthoracic echocardiography in the critical care setting. The small class sizes allow plenty of access to tutors. Students will practice on normal models and be exposed to pathology via pre-recorded images

Duration:

82 hours including 42 contact hours,
36 hrs independent workplace training
and 4hrs online tutorials.
